Exhibition Criteria

Accepted by vote July 1, 2018

1. The artist must be a member in good standing. Refer to Article III, section 3 of the by-laws:
 - a. “to be a member in good standing, one should attend a minimum of 5 meetings a year (within 12-month period) and be current on dues or be active on a committee.” For those who have not been a member long enough to have attended 5 meetings, this will not apply.
2. Artwork from previous BAA judged shows may not be in another judged show, however the artwork may be exhibited in our other galleries at St. Francis Hospital or Sweet Pea’s Table.
3. Wire must be used. Sawtooth hangers or hooks are permissible on works 8”x10” or smaller. Wire is to be placed 1/3rd of the way down the piece and should be taught.
4. Artwork must be framed, or gallery wrapped, and the paint should be dry. Transparent plastic may be used instead of glass (except for pastels).
5. The artist is responsible for their own artwork -- it is not insured.
6. The artist must deliver and pick up their artwork during the stated time frames or make arrangements for someone else to do so for them. Preferably the artwork will remain until the end of the show.
7. Two BAA artwork cards must be attached to the back of your work for juried shows and one for regular exhibits:
 - a. Your name and phone number
 - b. Title, medium, and price (or NFS). This card is used to reference your art and make a display card for the public.
 - c. A colored category indicator should be on the back of the card; red – **painting**, green – **non-painting**, yellow – **3D**

8. Originality is encouraged using your own unique touch. If your resources (photos, prints, magazines, art books, etc.) are not your own, you should change at least 60% of the original image to make it your own. If the artwork is copied, the original artist's name should be below your name.

9. Judges for our bi-annual judged shows may not be members of the BAA.

10. The Exhibition Committee can refuse artwork for an exhibit for the following reasons:
 - a. The artist is not in good standing with BAA
 - b. Artwork has structural malfunctions
 - c. Size or weight are more than can be accommodated by the venue
 - d. Inappropriate content

11. A \$5 fee for each painting entered in our bi-annual judged shows must accompany your piece. This money is used to pay for the judge with any leftover going into BAA account.

12. Drop off artwork in the staging area but leave the exhibition area so as not to interfere with the Exhibition Committee's work.
